Incentives for Healthy Behaviors!

This is a program that provides rewards loaded to a prepaid debit card. You earn rewards by completing easy healthy behaviors such as:

- Visiting your provider within 90 days of becoming a member
- Filling out a Health Risk Screening form
- Going to an annual breast cancer screening
- And more!

You can use your card to pay for health-related services and items at stores that participate in the Flexible Spending Accounts Benefits Program. You can also use your CentAccount card to pay for utilities such as gas, electricity, water and sewer.



Enhanced Vision for Adults

We cover an annual eye exam. Magnolia members can also get one pair of eyeglasses every 12 months.

Eligible members with complex care needs who do not have safe, reliable access to a telephone may be provided a temporary cell phone through our Connections Plus® program.
